- 6. Synthetic or merino mid-weight thermal long underwear top and bottom 1pr
- 7. Uninsulated synthetic softshell pants 2pr
- 8. Soft shell or fleece synthetic or wool zippered jacket with hood 2pr
- 9. Synthetic or wool pull overhoodie 1pr (Under Amour)
- 10. Dri-Down or synthetic compressible puffy coat and pants 1pr
- 11. Rain gear (Saddle Horn Outfitters strongly recommends quality rubberized rain gear from Helly Hansen or Grunden) If you choose to use Gore-Tex products, make sure it works before you are forced to rely on it for 7 days in Backcountry weather. 1pr
- 12. Hunting Boots 200 to 400 Gore-Tex 1pr
- 13. Boot insoles 1pr
- 14. Gaiters 1pr
- 15. Synthetic or wool gloves 3pr
- 16. Synthetic or wool cap 1
- 17. Baseball cap 1
- 18. Belt or suspenders 1
- 19. Camp shoes 1pr

- 1. Rifle (.284 caliber or larger)
- 2. Ammo (40 rounds, Choose premium bullets)
- 3. Rifle sling
- 4. Scope covers
- 5. Binoculars
- 6. Internal frame backpack

- 7. Rain cover for backpack
- 8. Water bottle or bladder
- 9. Headlamp (Bring a high quality, 100 lumen minimum headlamp)

- 12. Sleeping bag (With an EN rating of -15 to +10 deg F)
- 13. Sleeping pad (Inflatable is most comfortable if it holds air)
- 14. Waterproof stuff sack for sleeping bag
- 15. Waterproof stuff sack for clothing
- 16. Camera
- 17. Spare glasses or contacts
- 18. Sun glasses
- 19. Sun screen
- 20. Carmex
- 21. Lighter
- 22. Towel
- 23. Extra medication (Cold medication)
- 24. Ibuprofen
- 25. Blister pads (Mole skin)
- 26. Paperback book.
